

Oysterfest Agreement Governing Exhibitors

Operation Hours for All Exhibitors: Thursday 5pm-10pm, Friday 5pm-10pm, Saturday 10am-10pm, and Sunday 10am-6pm. Exhibitor must be prepared to occupy and sell product from the leased space by opening hours on Friday and must occupy and sell product from the leased space until closing time on Sunday. Please do not break down your booth early, it is not fair to the other vendors that are still selling their items. Breaking down your booth early may result in not receiving a booth for upcoming years. No motorized vehicle of any kind is allowed on the grounds 1 hour before Operating Hours. Violation of this rule may result in immediate cancellation and forfeiture of all rental money.

No car, recreation vehicles, or other motorized vehicles are allowed in the Exhibit Area of the Festival Grounds during specified hours. Once your products are unloaded each day, your vehicle is to be moved to designated parking outside the fenced area. There will be no over-night camping on the Festival Grounds. Violation of this rule means immediate cancellation of any agreement and forfeiture of all rental money.

The space as stipulated in this agreement is to be used only for the Exhibitor named on the contract during the dates specified.

The Exhibitor must provide all fixtures in exhibit area. (I.E. extension cords, tables, chairs, lights).

All improvements erected in said space shall be done at the expense of the Exhibitor; subject, however, to the approval of the Oysterfest Committee. Upon termination of an exhibit, all of said improvements should be removed at the expense of the Exhibitor, leaving the space in as well as condition as it was when it was occupied.

All Oysterfest Grounds remain under the control of the Oysterfest Committee and no demonstrators, banners, decorations, or advertising matter or special exhibits will be permitted except by prior approval.

The Exhibitor will not be permitted to exhibit any articles other than those approved in the application or display and advertise signs except his own.

No Pets will be permitted on Oysterfest Grounds. Violation of this rule can mean immediate cancellation of any agreement and forfeiture of all rental money, unless they are a Service Animal with appropriate paperwork.

The Oysterfest Committee reserves the right to remove or prohibit exhibits which for any reason are deemed objectionable and in their judgment may detract from the general character of the event. This reservation includes persons, things, conduct, printed matter, or anything which in the opinion of the Oysterfest Committee is deemed unacceptable.

The Exhibitor is entirely responsible for the space leased and he/she agrees to reimburse the Oysterfest Committee for any damages, which occur in the space, leased by the Exhibitor.

The Exhibitor will be solely responsible for his/her merchandise and exhibit. The Oysterfest Committee will not assume responsibility for theft or weather damage to merchandise.

The Exhibitor is responsible for submitting all applicable taxes directly to the proper agencies.

The lease, these rules and regulations and any other oral or written rules prescribed by the Oysterfest Committee shall be final and any violation thereof shall constitute default of the lease. Violation of this can mean immediate cancellation of any agreement and forfeiture of all rental money.

Absolutely no roving vendors allowed on Oysterfest Grounds.

The Fulton Volunteer Fire Department, the Oysterfest Committee, its officers, agents, employees, volunteers and other representatives shall not be held liable for and hereby are released from liability from any damages, loss, harm or injury to the person or property of the exhibitor or any of its officers, agents, employees, volunteers and other representatives, resulting from theft, fire, water, weather, accident or other reason. The exhibitor shall indemnify, defend or protect the Fulton Volunteer Fire Department, the Oysterfest Committee and hold harmless from any and all claims, demands, suits, liability, damages, loss expenses, attorney fees and expenses or any other nature which might result from or arise out of any action or failure to act on part of the exhibitor or any of its officers, agents, employees, volunteers or any other representatives.
